WICKED STYLE stalked the pace then ranged up to contend in the stretch and battled through the lane, dug in late and prevailed on the wire. GENERAL CHARLEY set the pace and led to the stretch, drifted out coming off the turn and battled through the long drive but was outfinished. CABERNEIGH was allowed to settle, angled four wide on the turn and was asked then closed willingly. TOP ECHELON settled along the inside and had a rail trip but made no rally. MARQ FRENCH rated in the second flight, was asked between on the turn but showed no response then faded.
