Footnotes

GENERAL CHARLEY broke sharply, moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the far turn and held well to the end under firm encouragement. TOM ARCHDEACON, held up between foes in the second flight in the opening half, continued under reserve while dropping off the second flight entering the second bend, briefly awaited an opening when lacking a path from which to challenge racing through the far turn, angled five wide in upper stretch and secured the place in the final strides. CRATER MAKER angled inwards to stalk just off the pacesetter to the far turn, couldn't gain terms with that foe in the final stages but continued with interest while just failing to contain a rival for second. FAITH'S MAGIC, held up off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out nearing the far turn to advance three deep, was fanned four wide entering upper stretch while lodging his bid between foes but was outkicked in the last furlong. BIG AL tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside to the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. UNO CHAPO, caught wide in the opening stages, made some brief progress outside foes to gain striking distance on the far turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. MINISTER'S JOY, reserved saving ground in the opening stages, never gained contention. CONSTABULARY was reserved outside a rival in the opening half but never mounted a serious challenge. D' WILDCARD trailed.
