Footnotes

GENERAL CHARLEY broke sharply, angled to the rail, was rated on a clear lead into the backstretch, then held sway to the end under some right handed prompting. ECONOMIC BAILOUT shifted outside the pacesetter while gaining a forward placing from the outset, stalked just outside the pacesetter in hand in the opening half, made an effort to press the leader racing into the far turn but couldn't match terms with that foe in the last quarter. MINISTER'S JOY, reserved along the inside in the opening half, saved ground throughout and made some late progress to improve his position. FAITH'S MAGIC moved outside foes to gain a tracking position just off the second flight, continued in that path into the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. PAISANO CREEK broke awkwardly, was settled just off the inside in the opening stages but never gained striking distance. SWORD AND SHIELD was a brief factor outside foes tracking the leaders but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. STRAIT OF MEWSINA (IRE), caught four wide racing into the backstretch, soon dropped out.
