Race 2:

2. LISA'S MAD AGAIN (Presser) (E) – Prime Power king was a convincing winner on this oval last time at this level and could easily be the one right back with even slight improvement in this field. Roger Brueggemann trainee has really gotten to get in good form on this oval as of late and dons a fine 4-2-1-0 mark on this Polytrack for a conditioner at 22% with a winner last time out. The bay mare could be placed anywhere in the race early on and should give pilot Emmanuel Esquivel a lot of options early on with the mare. A must use in all facets of this one.

4. WORKIN FOR HOPS (Presser) (D) – Old class horse was a stakes third on this oval two back and faces tons easier in this one as clearly the one to beat today. Six-year-old son of City Zip has possibly lost a step from his prime, but he has still been running big leading up to this and will have every chance to put this field away in the lane if he can relax even a bit in the early stages of this one. Trainer Chris Block is 21% all weather to turf, and we see no reason why not to back this classy gelding with Perez in the irons.
